



**Institutional Planning Advisory Committee (IPAC)
Results of Full Committee SCOT Voting
January 14, 2022**

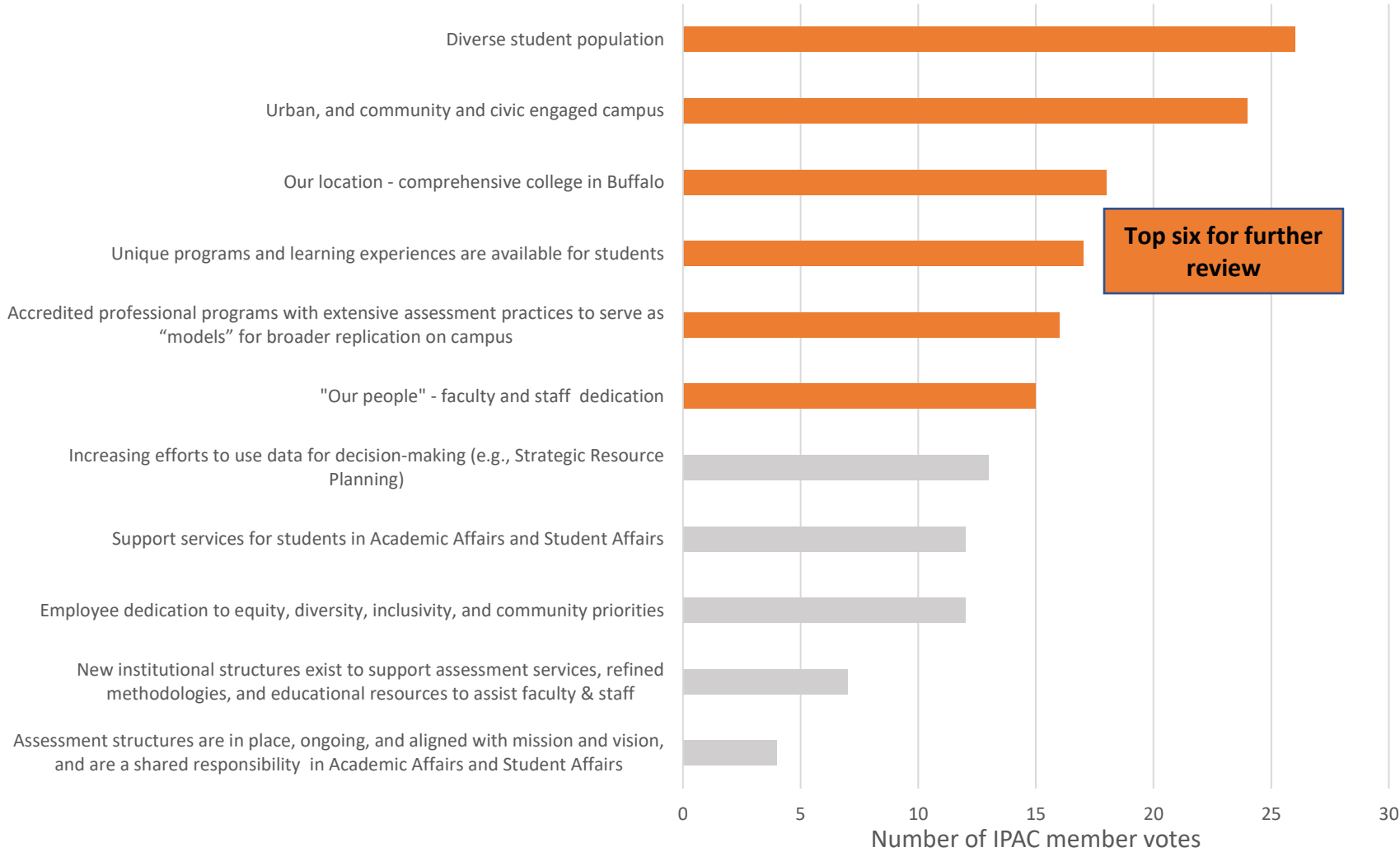
In Fall 2021, the five IPAC subcommittees were charged with creating a list of strengths, challenges, opportunities, and threats (SCOT) that they felt were of greatest importance to Buffalo State College. Among the lists of items created, the subcommittees voted on their top choices for each category. Results from each subcommittee were submitted to the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Planning where a final list was created. The final list was presented to all IPAC members in the form of a Qualtrics survey where members were asked to once more vote for their top choices within each SCOT category.

The four charts below show the SCOT results of the Qualtrics survey, with 29 (76%) of IPAC members responding to the survey. The lists of items within each SCOT category provided by each subcommittee are presented in the charts, as well as the final vote count for each item. The top 50% of responses (highlighted in orange) will move forward as IPAC subcommittees begin the next phase of planning that includes discussions regarding “Theory of Constraints.”

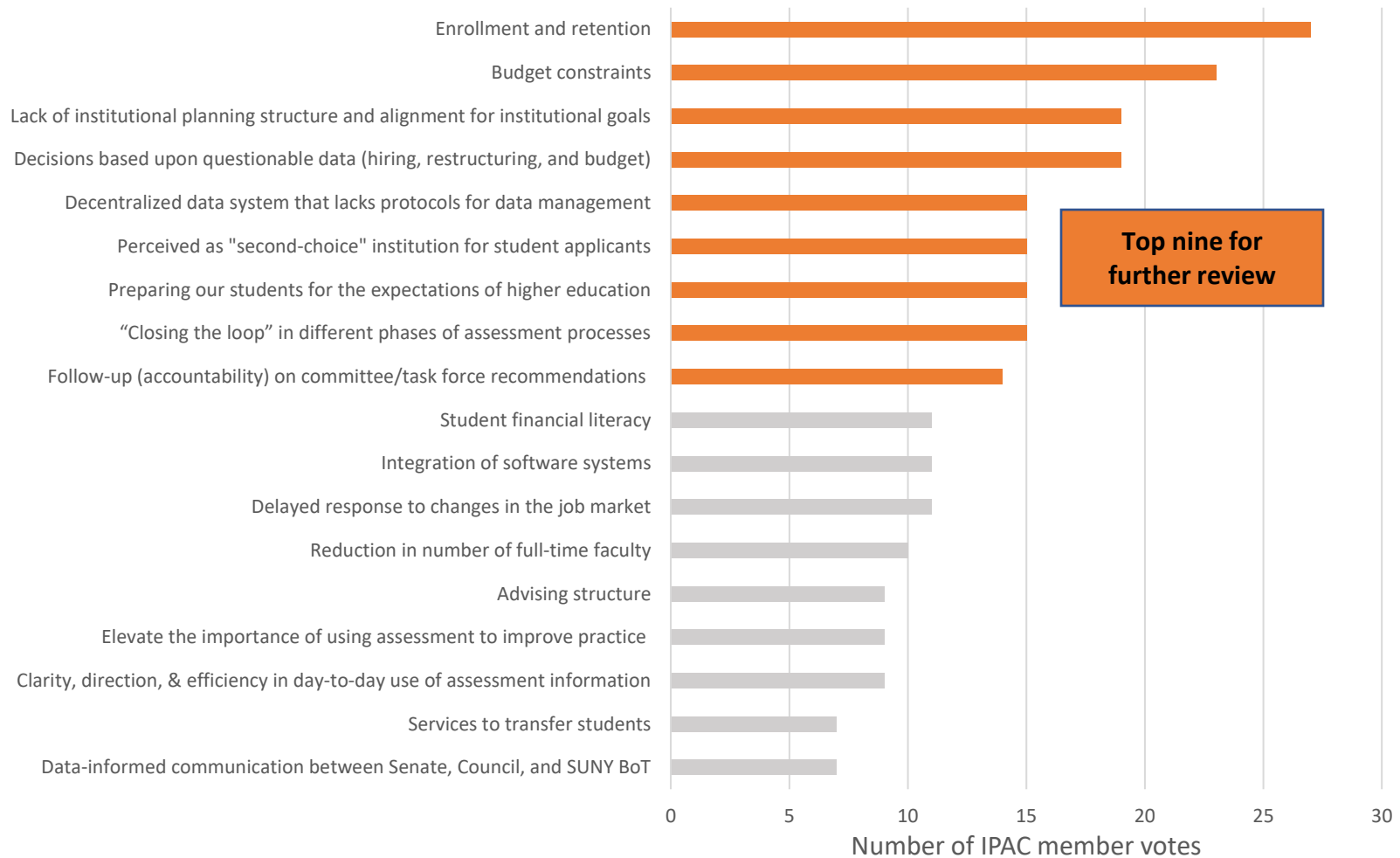

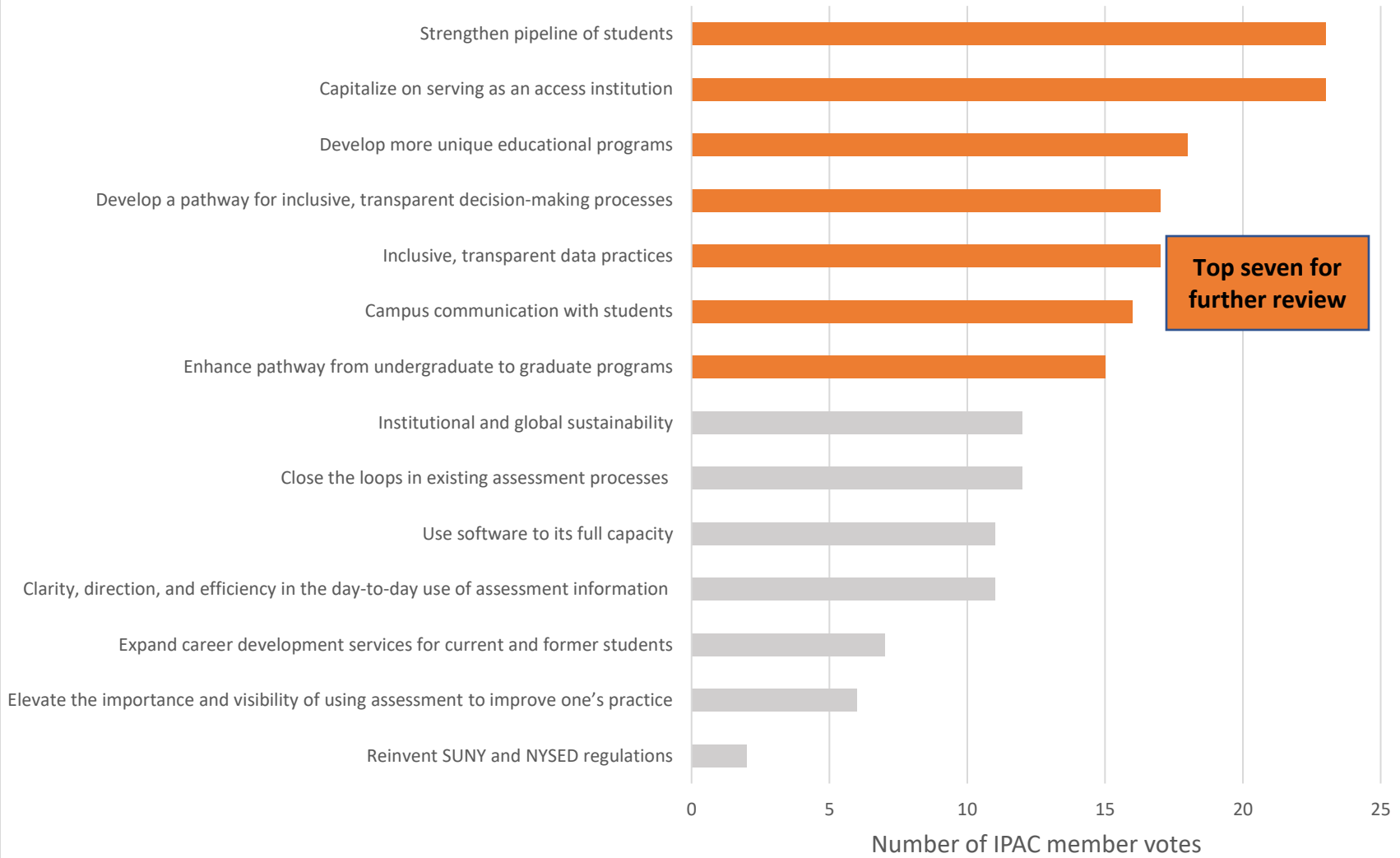
SCOT Analysis Results: STRENGTHS
